### **Detectives Arrest Man for First-Degree Murder in October Shooting**

**Pueblo, CO:** Detectives with the Pueblo County Sheriff's Special Investigation's Unit arrested a 35-year-old man on a warrant for first-degree murder in connection with the October 21, 2022, shooting death of Patti Magby, 73, at a residence in a rural area of southwest Pueblo County.

Max E. Struck was arrested without incident this afternoon. He has been booked into the Pueblo County Jail.

Magby was found shot outside a residence in the 4700 block of Bergemann Road on October 21, after sheriff's deputies responded to that location on a possible shots-fired call. Deputies attempted life-saving measures on Magby until medical personnel arrived. Magby was pronounced deceased at the scene.

An investigation determined that Magby's death was a homicide. Detectives learned the night of the incident, Magby, who lived nearby on Bergemann Road, had gone to Struck's residence for an unknown reason. Struck fired a gun and Magby, who was not armed, was killed.

"I commend our detectives for their thorough investigative work in this case that led to the arrest warrant being issued and this subsequent arrest," said Pueblo County Sheriff David J. Lucero.
