Detective obtains arrest warrant after assault on Deputies

Pueblo, CO: An arrest warrant was obtained for Laramie Fields following an incident on Friday August 4, 2023 in the Grease Monkey Parking lot in Pueblo West. A Deputy with the Pueblo County Sheriff's Office recognized Fields' vehicle and was able to see Fields' sleeping inside. Knowing Fields had multiple warrants for his arrest, other Deputies arrived, and a plan was formed to take Fields into custody safely, as he has a history of attempting to elude.

When Fields awoke, he started his vehicle and rammed multiple patrol vehicles causing several thousand dollars in damage and drove directly towards one Deputy, who suffered serious bodily injury after being hit by a vehicle. Deputies eventually used less lethal methods to take Fields into custody as safely as possible. Another Deputy was treated for injuries to his hand. Both Deputies have since recovered. Fields was transported to the Pueblo County Detention Facility where he was booked on his warrants.

A search warrant was granted for Fields' truck and a defaced firearm was located. In addition to his prior warrants, Fields now has additional charges of Assault in the First Degree, Second Degree Assault on a Peace Officer, Vehicular Assault, Criminal Mischief, Possession of a Defaced Firearm, Resisting Arrest, Reckless Endangerment and Violation of a Protection Order. He is currently being held on a \$150,000 cash only bond.
